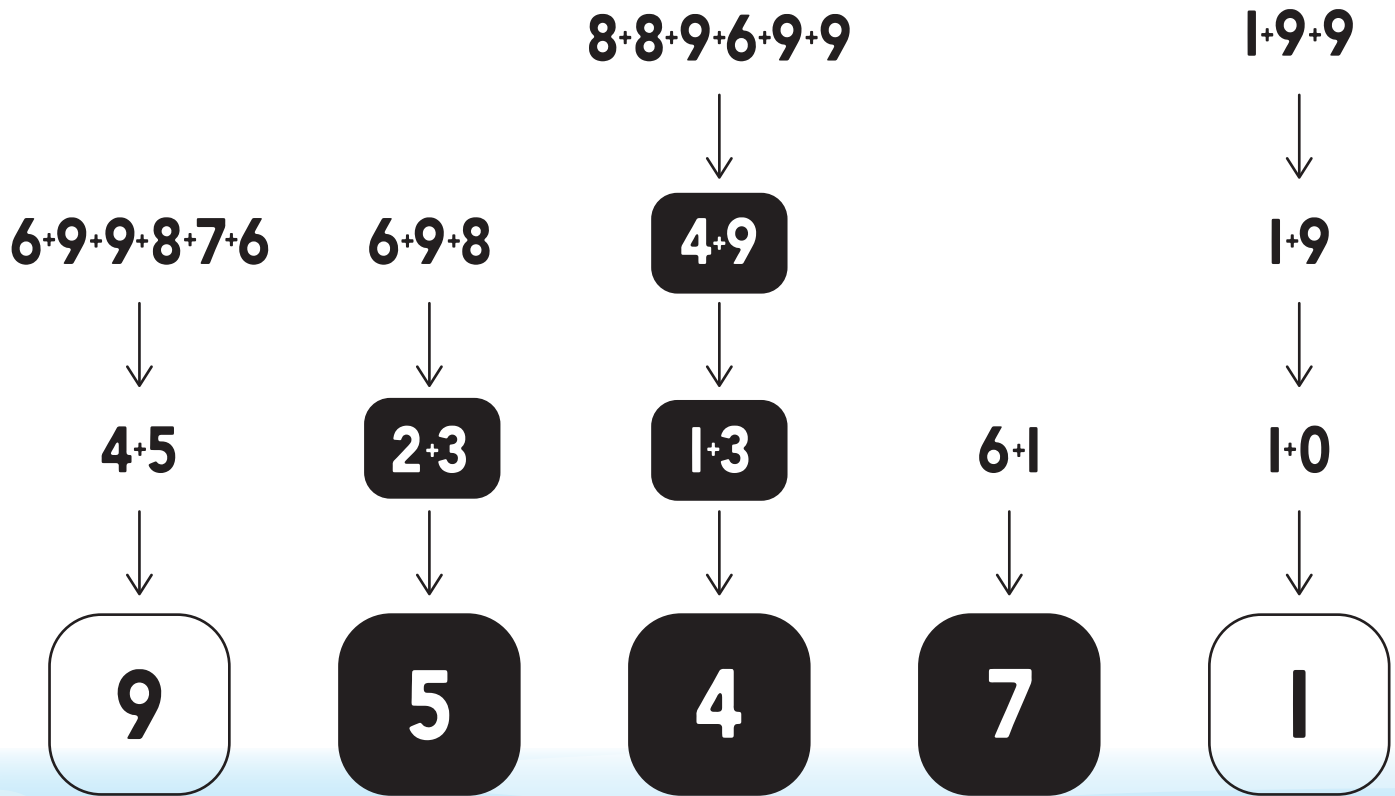


# SILVERQUICKEN SUMMER PUZZLE #2 SOLUTION

Think of each number as a set of digits. Add each digit in the set to get the next number in the chain. You keep going down the column until you get to a single digit, which is the last number in the chain. You get **95,471**, the total number of shorelines in the US.\*
